She is working on representing fundamental questions about homogenization of cultural, ecological, or geological process in the congeries of time. Her art works include painting, drawing, and photography. She received her Master of Fine Arts from the School of the Museum of Fine Arts, Boston with a joint degree from Tufts University in 2010. She has had nine solo exhibitions and participated in numerous group exhibitions internationally since 1999. Her artistic achievements include the Traveling Scholarship from the School of the Museum of Fine Arts, Boston (2012), Artist Fellowship from the Terra Foundation for American Art (2010), and the first prize in Yousuf Karsh Prize in Photography (2010). She was awarded artist-in-residency fellowships from PLAYA (2017), The Cooper Union School of Art (2015), Helen Wurlitzer Foundation (2013), Terra Summer Residency (2010), and so on. She occasionally travels to Iceland (2009, 2011, 2017) and Norway (2012) for her photography projects, which inspires her new series of paintings.
