Howard Yezerski Gallery is pleased to announce *Anything: More Parts of the Whole, Old and New*, an exhibition of painting and drawing by Sam Cady. This is Cady's 8th exhibition with the gallery. An Opening Reception will be held Saturday, October 29th between 2-5pm.

Sam Cady has been drawing and painting bits and pieces of the world for 70 years alternating between built structures and nature. After many years of working, Cady realized that structures of shelter, protection and transport played against earth, space, and exposure. This juxtaposition of subject matter was a recurring theme the artist was exploring almost unconsciously. *Anything: More Parts of the Whole, Old and New* offers a variety of such subject matter which makes connections not only to the innate beauty of nature, but the subtle beauty of ordinary man-made objects. Cady plays with the scale and perspective of his work while keeping the structural element of the object by meticulously sculpting his stretchers and cutting the canvas. The results are sometimes illusionistic while other works are obscure, requiring the viewer to consider the space within the composition. Ultimately, Cady is heightening our awareness of everything around us all the time.
